Dear Mr. Morrison:

Beginning in 2006, the Fairfax County Department of Transportation (FCDOT) began implementation of the Board of Supervisors' Comprehensive Bicycle Infrastructure Program, a program that encompasses a variety of initiatives directed at making Fairfax County "bicycle friendly". One critical element of the program is the On-Road Bike Lane Initiative. The intent of this initiative is twofold:

- Establish a list of roadways that can be retrofitted with on-road bike lanes by modification of pavement markings and the addition of signage. In October 2006, the first on-road bike lane project, Gallows Road from Tyson's Corner to the Washington and Old Dominion Trail (W&OD), Phase 1 was presented as part of VDOT's project day. Subsequently, Phases 2 and 3 will extend the on-road bike lanes from the W&OD trail to US Route 29.
- Coordinate with VDOT Maintenance staff to insure that roadways scheduled for summer maintenance (repaving and overlay) that have been identified as an on-road bicycle route, are retrofitted as part of that maintenance action.

The success of this program initiative is dependent upon the level of coordination, cooperation, and effort between Fairfax County and the Virginia Department of Transportation. To date, FCDOT and your staffs from Arlington-Fairfax Preliminary Engineering, Traffic Engineering, Maintenance, Planning, Environmental, and Location and Design have been working together to make this program element a reality.
